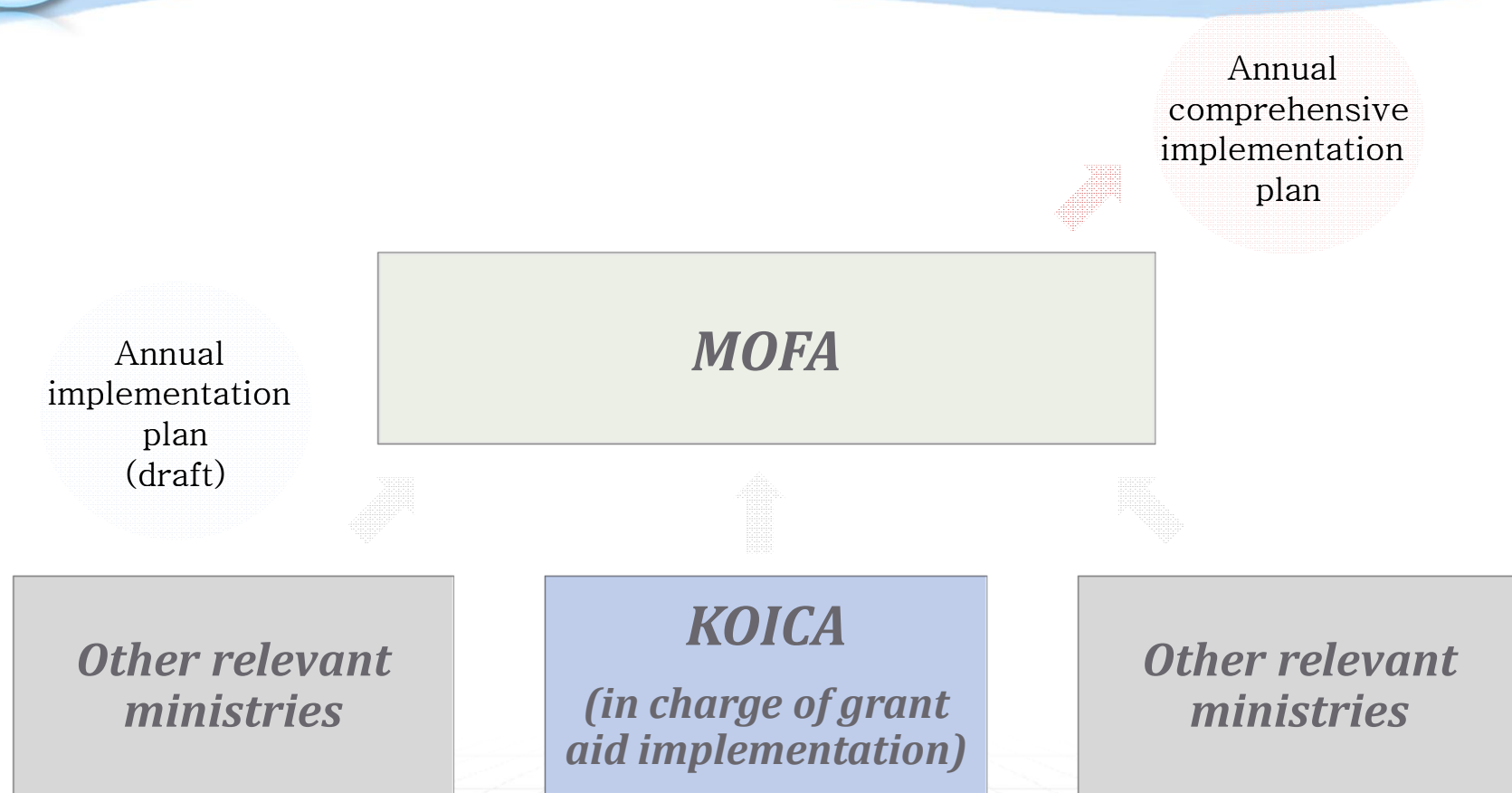

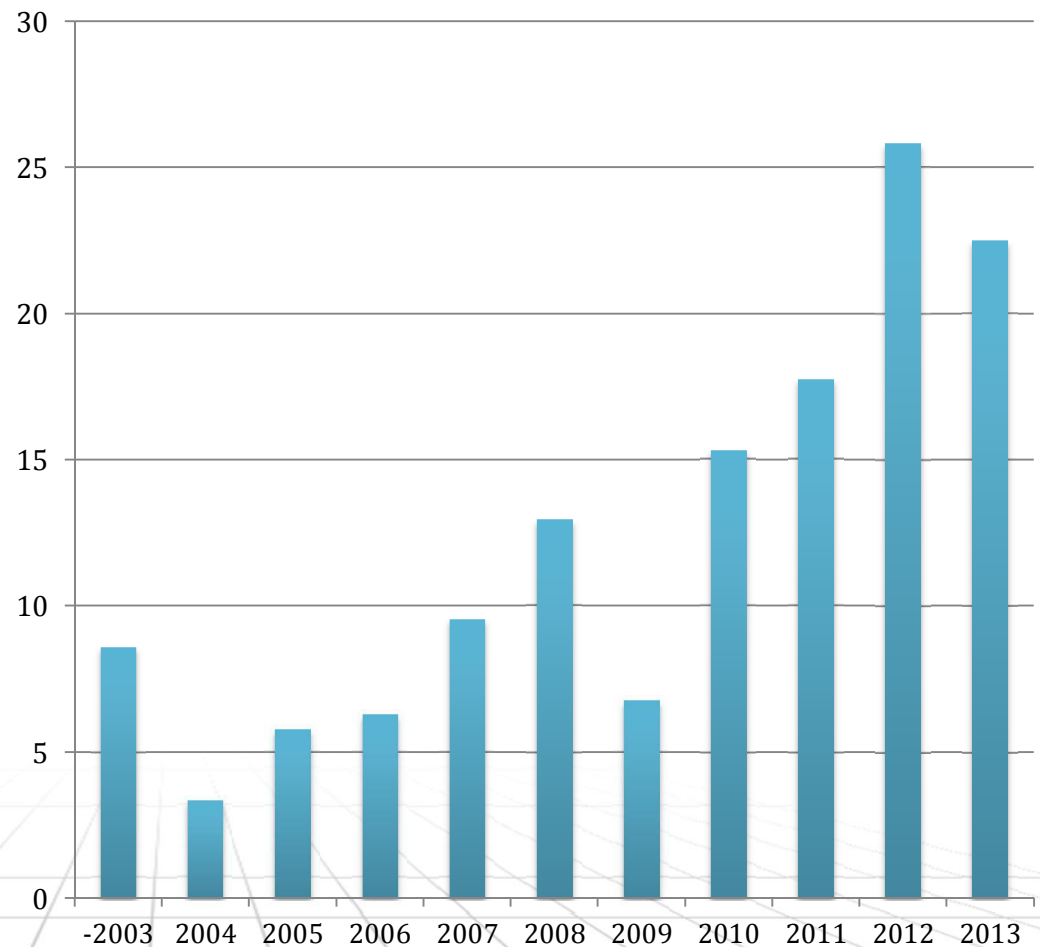
KOICA in Cambodia
