OUTCOME I

SEXUAL REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH AND RIGHTS

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CPAP Outcome and Outputs



Outcome 1:

Increased availability and use of integrated sexual and reproductive health services (including family planning, maternal health and HIV) that are gender-responsive and meet human rights standards for quality of care and equity in access.

Output 1:

Increased national capacity to accelerate demand and improve delivery of quality integrated sexual and reproductive health services, including family planning, that are gender-sensitive, youth-friendly and rights-based

Output 2:

Increased national capacity to deliver comprehensive maternal health services

Key Programme Interventions of Output 1



KEY PRIORITY 1: Strategies, guidelines and protocols on Sexual Reproductive Health and Rights



No	Main intervention
1	Develop strategies, guidelines, protocols and manuals related to Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights; Maternal Health, Adolescents and Youth, and Family Planning
2	Develop national capacity for dissemination and implementation of the developed policies, guidelines, protocols, and manuals



KEY PRIORITY 2: Health facilities providing high-quality youth-friendly services



No	Main intervention
1	Develop and implement Adolescent and Youth Friendly Services (AYFS) Guidelines and Manual, quality capacity development for AYFS including M & E
2	Improve quality family planning/birth spacing counseling, services and information for women of reproductive age, men, and adolescents and youth; HIV and cervical cancer
3	Create supportive environment including coordination at the sub-national level under the D & D framework (Implementation Plan Phase 2) for youth and adolescents and Sexual Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR)



KEY PRIORITY 3: Comprehensive SRHR social behavior change communication strategy for adolescents and youth

1	Develop and implement comprehensive Sexual

	» Entertainment workers
	» Factory workers

2	Improve knowledge management and support

Key Programme Interventions of Output 2



KEY PRIORITY 1: National pre-service midwifery training standards



No	Main intervention
1	Develop and implement:
	» Midwifery Education Pathway
	» Scope of practices for midwives
	» Midwifery education regulatory framework
	» Curriculum review and update, national exit exam
	» National strategy for midwifery
2	Integrate Emergency Obstetric and Newborn Care (EmONC), Family Planning, Violence Against Women, Gender, adolescent and youth health into training curricula and pre-service education
3	Capacity development for lecturers and preceptors; and commission midwifery review



KEY PRIORITY 2: Emergency Obstetric and Newborn Care



No	Main intervention
1	Emergency Obstetric and Newborn Care (EmONC) and nurse anesthesia training and post-training follow up
2	Address shortfall of key signal functions of each EmONC facility
3	Strengthen Maternal Death Surveillance and Response, and maternity waiting home
4	Capacity development for midwifery skills and competencies to health staff and lecturers/trainers
