# OUTCOME 2: ADOLESCENTS AND YOUTH

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#### **CPAP Outcome and Outputs**



#### **Outcome 2:**

Increased priority on adolescents, especially on very young adolescent girls, in national development policies and programmes, particularly increased availability of comprehensive sexuality education and sexual and reproductive health services.

#### **Output 1:**

Increased national and subnational capacity to advocate for increased investment in youth within development policies and programmes, with young people's full participation.

#### Output 2:

Increased national capacity in designing and implementing systematic comprehensive sexuality education.

The Comprehensive Sexuality Education Integration as part of Health Education in National Core Curriculum

	2) Revise and finalize the Health Education textbooks in line with the revised Syllabus to include age appropriate content on CSE for grade 5 to 12.



#### **KEY PRIORITY 2:**

The Comprehensive Sexuality Education Integration as a part of Health Education in the National Core Curriculum

1	1) Support the development of teacher training on CSE so that MoEYS can roll out the Health Education/CSE curriculum nationwide; and
	2) Provide technical and capacity building support to MoEYS in the roll out of teacher training on the Health Education/CSE in three priority provinces
