#### **CPAP Outcome and Outputs**



#### **Outcome 3:**

Advanced gender equality, women's and girls' empowerment, and reproductive rights, including for the most vulnerable and marginalized women, adolescents and youth.

#### Output 1:

Strengthened capacity of national and subnational governments, involving civil society, in promoting sexual reproductive health and rights and preventing violence against women and girls.

#### Output 2:

Strengthened national and subnational health system capacity to address violence against women and girls within the coordinated multi-sectoral response.

## Key Programme Interventions of Output 1



#### KEY PRIORITY 1: Interventions that engage men and boys in preventing VAWG



No	Main intervention
1	Support MoWA in adapting a model on preventing violent behaviours and promoting healthy attitudes and behaviours towards girls and women. The model intervention will be for adolescent boys and girls aged 12-14 years old and for their parents and carers adapted to Cambodian context and implemented in one province.
2	Evaluate the 2 pilot interventions to review the possibility of scale-up by MOWA and partners across the country to support the implementation of the NAPVAW.



### KEY PRIORITY 1: Interventions that engage men and boys in preventing VAWG



No	Main interventions
3	Design targeted interventions that engage men and boys in the prevention of violence through the use and analysis of new data sets including the CDHS 2014 and the WHO violence prevalence study.
4	Support MOWA in the review of the NAPVAW and the results of all partners programs in preventing violence against women and girls

## Key Programme Interventions of Output 2



#### **KEY PRIORITY 2:**





No	Main interventions
1	Develop a training strategy for scale up of the health sector response to Violence Against Women and Girls (VAWG) - in collaboration b/t MoH and WOWA
2	Develop competency based training curriculum for health providers based on the National Guidelines
3	Capacity development of trainers in competency based curriculum for health workers
4	Roll out and implement of the competency based training of health workers in selected 3 referral hospitals and facilities in high priority provinces where data suggests that there is a higher prevalence of violence



# KEY PRIORITY 2: Referral hospitals providing services for survivors of VAWG according to national guideline



No	Main interventions
	Finalize the clinical handbook which is adapted to the Cambodian context and in line with the National Guidelines and develop other important job aid and tools
	Develop quality assurance monitoring tool to ensure that health services provided to survivors of violence are in accordance with the National Guidelines
	Strengthen coordination role at subnational levels for setting up and improving the referral network for survivors of violence to and from health services by MOWA
