Phase 1 – How do we score?

Taken from the self-assessment responses

	GPs	DPs
We have spent time understanding the resources each partner brings	55%	33%
We have spent time building equity and trust?	82%	67%
There is clear agreement about what the TWG will and will not do	27%	53%
The role of the lead is facilitator clear	55%	40%

Phase 2 – How do we score?

Taken from the self-assessment responses

	GPs	DPs
We are finding solutions to competing priorities	64%	71%
New partners are being oriented well into TWGs	45%	53%
We openly discuss the issue of multiple agendas	82%	38%
Each partner is fulfilling commitments made in Phase 1	45%	46%

Phase 3 – How do we score?

Taken from the self-assessment responses

	GPs	DPs
We regularly review roles and responsibilities	27%	33%
There are unresolved issues that prevent progress	64%	79%
We are giving attention to strengthening capacity to partner	45%	33%
We are sharing what works	64%	43%

Phase 4 – How do we score?

Taken from the self-assessment responses

	GPs	DPs
Partnerships are being established between institutions	55%	33%
Lessons are being applied systematically to existing and new TWGs	55%	36%
Discussions are taking place about how to mainstream the TWG work	45%	71%
