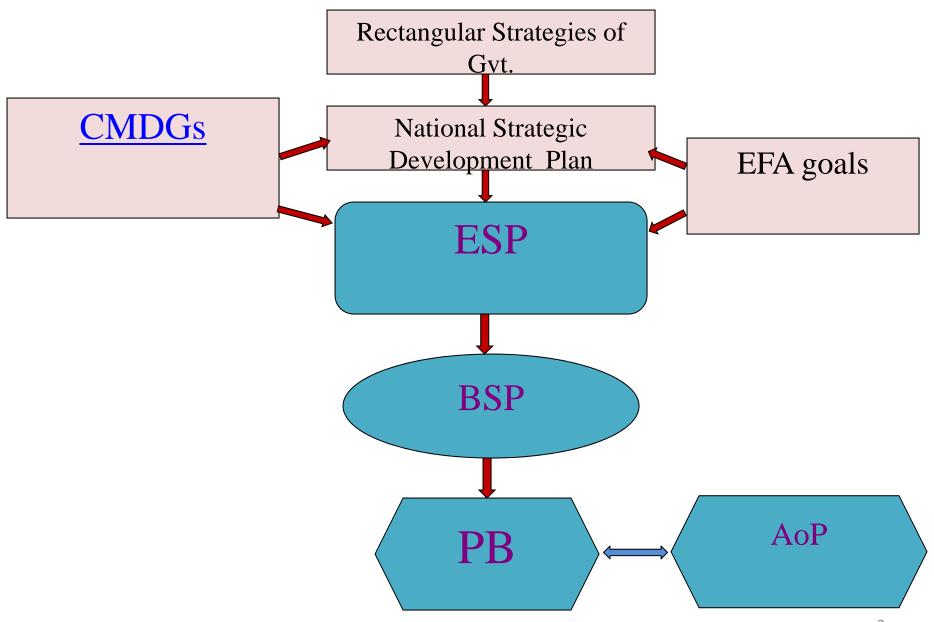

- In ESP, there is Core Breakthrough Indicators to make more focused on
- Linkage between policies, strategies/program, and subprogram/ activities

- Moving from Departmental Planning to Sub-Sector
 Planning-ECE, Primary, Secondary, Higher
 Education, Non-Formal Education, Youth, and Sports
- Using Cambodian Analysis and Projection Model (Canpro) for facilitating decision making (inputoutput) and for checking balance what we want and what we can
- Focus on outcome indicators level.

Annual Operational Plan (AoP)

- AoP lists down activities need to be implemented within a year
- AOP could facilitate monitoring activities and evaluating results
- AOP is a mechanism for mobilizing resources of activities, showing transparent
- AOP contributes in promoting responsibility of all relevant partners working in the education sector to harmonize, alignment and outcome management.

Issues and lession learned

- Linkage between Joint Monitoring Indicator (JMI), Sector Core Breakthrough Indicators (CBIs), and resource mobilization and allocation.
- Continue to strengthen government/ ministry system and encourage DPs to use it through improved capacity (individual, process/system, institutional) through CD Master Plan and NIE

Issues and Lesson learned (conti.)

- Promote policy dialogues and participations from all stakeholders, and sound evidence-based
- Linkage between planning and budgeting-full PB
- Improved Result focused planning at Micro level, since Aid Effectiveness could not be talked at policy level-ESP at Provincial level, and AoP at Provincial and District levels.
- Improved result based M&E-Institutionalize and research
